Eligibility Requirements

- Be currently enrolled at least half-time (as defined by your institution) in an undergraduate, degree-seeking program at an accredited two-year or four-year U.S. college or university
- Commit to using funds as designated
 - Commit to contributing to The Big Picture College Emergency Fund when you are financially able to do so
 - Have applied and utilized all federal, state, and institutional financial aid
 - Have an UNFORESEEN FINANCIAL EMERGENCY related to your studies
